Required Qualifications/Essential Duties:

- A.A., A.S. or Bachelor’s Degree (B.A) from an accredited four year college or university preferred in computer science, information systems or equivalent in MIS/IT professional – **Preferred**;
- Minimum five years of hands-on experience with network design, operational support, hands-on implementation and configuration of switches, routers, firewall, IDS, IPS, VPN, S.I.M. and baling in different LAN/WAN environments;
- Valid California Driver License – **Required**;
- Must be insurable through company’s carrier and maintain throughout employment – **Preferred**;
- Valid and current CCNA certification (Cisco certified network associated) – **Required**;
- Valid and current CCNP certification (Cisco certified network professional) – **Required**;
- CompTIA Certification either (Network + or Security +) – **Required**;
- Microsoft Certified System Administrator (MCSA) or Microsoft Certified Technology Specialist (MCTS) – **Preferred**;
