Required Qualifications/Essential Duties:

- High School Diploma or GED
- 4 years' experience working in Water Monitoring Programs and Distribution Systems
- Water Quality Monitoring, Solid Waste and Recycling Programs;
- Implement Water Quality outreach and training programs to employees, children and community members;
- Implement environmental projects relative to environmental resources on Santa Rosa Rancheria;
- Identify potential problem areas in environmental projects and programs implemented on the Santa Rosa Rancheria;
- Prepare reports to summary data and cost-effective purchase analysis;
- Drive to various locations within and of the SRR Community to ensure appropriate actions are followed according to policies and procedures;
- Ensure test samples are extracted from established points on the Reservation;
- Determine and ensure the kinds and amounts of chemicals to be use in water systems;
- Determine and ensure appropriate amounts to destroy microbes and other harmful organisms, basing amounts of findings of Microbiologist;
- Assist EPA Environmental Specialist with Solid Waste Program as it pertains to the Water Quality Monitoring Programs;
- Monitor tanks, pumps and motors;
- Drive to training, seminars, conferences, both local and out of the area within California.
