Required Qualifications/Essential Duties:

- Must have High School Diploma or General Education Degree (GED) plus three years experience in related field;
- Valid California Driver license- **REQUIRED**;
- Must be insurable through the company insurance carrier and maintain throughout employment-**REQUIRED**;
- Must be able to obtain a California Gaming License and maintain throughout employment- **REQUIRED**;
- Responsible for the operation of the Surveillance department and all management related issues as directed by the Assistant Director;
- Responsible for coordinating surveillance efforts to protect the Santa Rosa Rancheria Tachi-Yokut Tribe's assets and to maintain the integrity of all gaming activities;
- Accountability for all Surveillance policies and procedure as it applies to the Tribal/State Compact, National Indian Gaming Commission (NIGC), Tribal Gaming Regulations, and Company Internal Controls {hereinafter: Rules and Regulations}
- Protect the assets of the Santa Rosa Rancheria Tachi-Yokut Tribe and Tachi Palace Hotel & Casino;
- Maintaining the integrity of gaming as applicable to Rules and Regulations;
- Explain and enforce rules of the Surveillance Department with the approval of the Surveillance Assistant Director;
- Train Surveillance personnel in monitoring Live Gaming Devices, Electronic Gaming Devices, and Internal Control Procedures;
- Ensure compliance with applicable Rules and Regulations;
- Observe, evaluate, and report irregularities to appropriate department heads or the Gaming Commission;
- Provide accurate and professional reports to the Gaming Commission as required;
- Knowledge of all surveillance operations including but not limited to digital and analog stations, surveillance system setups and all technical requirements;
- Other duties as assigned;
- Drive company vehicle or personal vehicle to conduct business on behalf of the Surveillance department.
