Required Qualifications/Essential Duties:

- Must have High School Diploma or General Education Degree (GED) plus a minimum of 1 year experience working in Water Monitoring Programs and Distribution System.- **REQUIRED**
- CA State License- Water Distribution Grade II – Required (or must acquire within 6 months of hire)
- Must have valid California Driver License – **REQUIRED**
- Must be insurable by companies' insurance carrier and maintain throughout employment – **REQUIRED**
- Water Quality Monitoring, Solid Waste, and Recycling Program.
- Implement Water Quality outreach and training programs to employees, children and community members
- Implement environmental projects relative to environmental resources on Santa Rosa Rancheria;
- Identify potential problems areas in environmental projects and program implemented on the Santa Rosa Rancheria;
- Prepare reports to summary data and cost-effective purchase analysis;
- Drive to various location within and of the SRR community to ensure appropriate actions are followed according to policies;
