- Develop Air Quality Monitoring , Solid Waste, and Recycling Programs;
- Implement Air Quality and Recycling outreach and training programs to employees, children and community members;
- Implement environmental projects relative to environmental resources on Santa Rosa Rancheria;
- Identify potential problem areas in environmental projects and programs implemented on the Santa Rosa Rancheria;
